Randy Boone ASMCS, U.S. Coast Guard retired in 1996 as a Senior Chief Aviation Survivalman. With over 4000 hrs as a U.S. Coast Guard Aircrew member aboard C-130s and HU-25A aircraft and firsthand experience searching for persons in the water. Randy has designed a wearable survival pouch and a lifevest signal kit that allows general aviation pilots to have a means to signal searching aircraft after a water ditching and egress. The seminar will be followed by a test of pilots capacity to handle water survival situation. Prize will be given to best performing team.
